

# ACHILLEA



*Asteraceae* / *Milfoil*

Perennial with short growing period, suitable for cut or dried flower production or as a patio or garden border plant. Sowing to flowering takes 3 months.

Sow in spring for abundant flowering the same year.

Sow in pots or outdoors 10 g/m<sup>2</sup>. Plant out in a sunny position.

A018 F2 'Summerpastels', 60 cm, mixture of pastel colours: salmon, rose, scarlet, cream, orange and yellow.



A014 'Colorado', 60 cm, mixture of intense colours. Sowing to flowering takes 3 months.



A015 filipendulina 'Cloth of Gold', 120 cm, bronze - yellow flowers on long, sturdy stems. Suitable for drying.



A017 millefolium 'Cherry Red', 60 cm, cherry - red.



A013 ptarmica 'The Pearl White', 60 cm, pearly white. High percentage of fully double flowers.



A021 tomentosa 'Aurea', 20 cm, yellow.
