

CAMPANULA CARPATICA

Campanulaceae / Bell - flower



Sow in plugs (5 - 8 seeds / plug). Light germinator. Supplementary lighting up to 10 - 12 hours will be needed for sowings made up to the winter months. For flowers in winter extend days up to 16 hours. Just before buds start to develop, pour with 1 cc/l Cycocel7 (rinse) or spray with 0,75 - 1,5 cc/l Cycocel7.

F1 'Pearl'

Lovely early pot selection. Valuable as a summer pot plant or bedding plant. Flowers of an intense deep blue are produced uniformly.

C063 'Pearl Deep Blue', blue, very uniform.

C064 'Pearl White', white, very uniform.

C068 'Pearl Light Blue', a dense crown of large light blue flowers on a compact plant.

'Clips'

Slightly later than Pearl. Later on, this strain can be planted out and will perform very well in the garden over many years.

C035 'Clips Deep Blue', 20 cm, flowers of an intense blue are produced over a deep-green foliage.
